Academic Dishonesty Appeal Any student who has been penalized for academic dishonesty has the

academic affairs will render a decision within two weeks and copies of such decision will be sent to the student, the faculty member, the campus executive director/dean, and the dean of the school involved. This decision shall be final in all cases of grade appeals.

Failure to submit grade appeals within the required time period will negate the student's complaint.

Graduate Admission Decision Appeal An applicant may appeal an admission decision to the Graduate Council. The appeal should be routed through the vice president of external campuses and graduate services.
