## **MLA In-Text Citations**

*You may need to reference a variety of sources in your paper. It is essential in MLA that those references be parenthetically cited. MLA follows the “author-page” formatting style for all sources—print and electronic. In the event that your source lacks an author, the citation will include a shortened version of the source’s title and a page number. If the author is mentioned in*

*the signal phrase, the parenthetical reference will only contain the page number.*
