Specific Guidelines

A completeAPA in-text citationincludes the author's last name, year publication, and pagenumber or range where the formation is located, and it looks like this: (Author, year, p.#).

As with anydocumentation style, there are a varieft ways to correctly present quotes and in-text citations. This helps to provide varied sentence structure and to avoid dull writing.

Herearesomeexamples:

- x "JackandJill went upthehill to fetcha pail of water" (Jones, 2000, p.1).
- x According to Jone (2000), Jackand Jill hadonly gone to secure water supply (p. 1).
- x Jones(2000) wrotethat "JackandJill went upthehill to fetcha pail of water" (p. 1).

Whenusing signal phrases, uspasttenseor present perfect tense.

For example: "Kelvin (2003) found that the..." OR "Kelvin (2003) has found that the..."

Examples

<u>Citing Two Works by the SameAuthor Publishedn the SameYear:</u>

Whenciting two sources by the same authorin the same year, use lowerse letter (a, b, c) with the year of differentiate the entries in the reference list Also, use the same lowerse letter with the year in the intext citation.

- x Smith (2012b)also concedethat "when a personlosessleep, the bodykeepstrack and creates a 'sleep deficit'" (p. 670).

Citing aWork byTwo Authors:

Both authors'namesappear imparentheses in the signal phrase achtime you cite the work. Use the word "and" between authors' names within the text. However, you should use the ampersand (&) between the names in parentheses.

- x As ZhangandLiu (2012)stated, "This articleaims to contribute the existing literature in two main aspects" (p. 1490).
- x "This article aims to contribute to the existing literature in two main aspects' (Zhang & Liu, 2012, p.1490).

Citing a Work by Threeto Five Authors:

The first time you cite the source, you must list all the authors in the spigmasse or in parentheses. The word "and" appears between the authors ham eswithin the text, and the ampersand (&) appears in the parentheses.

x Morriss, Bogart, Meiners, and Dorchak (2011) conceded that "diversification makes sense only if the new sources of energy are **effective** and reliable" (p. 19).

When subsequently citing the same work, use only the first author's last name followed by "et al." in the signaphrase or in pæntheses. Also, if it is the first time within a paragraph to mentionthat particulareference, include year publication parentheses fter "et al." You may omit the year fronthe reference if it is repeated within that same paragraph.

x Morriss et al. (2011) also wrote, "The best wayencourage development of new technologies's not for the government o select some favoreathes and subsidize them (p.19).

Citing a Workby Six or More Authors:

The first author's ast name will appear followed byet al." in both the signal phrase and the parentheses.

- x Ammari et al. (2014) wrote that "both the preserve dand deteriorate opatterns also exist in the general population" (p. 355).
- x As previouslynoted, "boththepreserved and deteriorated patterns also exist ithe general population" (Ammari et al., 2014, p. 355).

Citing a Work with No Author:

If a sourcedoesnot list its authoryou may use the entire source title in the signal phrase or shorten the itle and cite it in the parenthetical reference. Titles books and reports will be
