WHAT IS THE CLERY ACT?

- Jeann Clery was raped and murdered in her dorn room at Lehigh University in 1986. Her killer was another student. Her parents believe she would h been more cautious if she had known about othe violent crimes at Lehigh.
- Congress agreed. Todery Act, first enacted in 1990 and amended in 1998, requires higher education institutions to report crime statistics to current & prospective students & employees.

I'M A CAMPUS SECURITY AUTHORITY WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

- If someone tells you about a crime or and incide that may be a crime, you must record the information and submit it to the/ayland Baptist UniversityPoliceDepartment.
- <u>Justget the facts</u>, Police will investigate and tabulate appropriate statistics.



WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO? When in doubt.

REPORT





LOCATION, LOCATION, LOCATION

- You must report if it occurred
- On campus
- On campus, in residence halls
- On public property adjacent to campus
- On non-campus property owned or controlled by the University or a recognized student organizati

ARSON (SOMETHING WAS BURNED)

- What was burned or attempted to be burned?
- Was anyone hurt?
- Was property damaged? How much?
- When did it happen?
- When was it discovered?
- Was there graffiti or other evidence of hate motivation?





HATE CRIMES- PROPERTY

- Was the target personal property, a personal resider business, house of worship, or ethnic organization?
- Was property damaged? Value?
- Did the attack include any expression related to race gender, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity, or disability?
- Report ANY vandalism to a house of worship, or eth religious or Gay or Lesbian organization as a hate crime.



LIQUOR, DRUG, WEAPONS LAW VIOLATION

- Police must keep statistics on numbers of people arrested for liquid law violations, drug law violations and illegal weapons possession
- Student housing and student judicial affairs officers must keep statistics on number of peopleferred for disciplinary action for drug, liquor law and weapons violations.
 - Disciplinary referrals should not include incidents in which the person is als arrested for the same offense.
- Statistics must reflect total number of persons involved, not incide
